

Effective December 17th, 2008, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Nova Scotia Department of Natural Resources, the following prohibitions apply:

1. No person may operate a motorized vehicle at any time, with the exception of snow vehicles from December 1st of each year until March 31st of the following year and mobility aids for the mobility impaired;
2. No person may operate a snow vehicle between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. Local time;
3. No person may operate a snow vehicle in excess of 50 kilometres per hour in areas where the speed limit has been posted with signs;
4. No person who owns, or is in control of, a dog may permit it to be off-leash;
5. No person may hunt, trap, take or snare any wildlife or attempt to do the same;
6. No person may have in their possession or discharge a loaded firearm or bow; and
7. No person may have in their possession an unloaded firearm or bow unless the firearm or bow is permitted to be carried under the Wildlife Act and regulations and
 - a. is in a case which is properly fastened,
 - b. is completely wrapped in a material which is securely tied around the firearm or bow, or
 - c. in the case of a firearm, is rendered inoperable by the attachment of a trigger lock to the firearm.

The foregoing prohibitions do not apply to:

law enforcement staff or Department of Natural Resources staff engaged in the execution of their duties;
operators of emergency vehicles; or
operators of vehicles used for construction or maintenance of the trail.
